




SEWING Sew over the entire sheet of labels before cutting out, or cut and then sew label to a cool piece of paper. Glue layered piece to your page.





















QUIRKY HANDPAINTED print&cut LABELS



WHAT YOU CAN DO:

- 1. Use the labels to cut & print & stick on your personal journals, art, scrapbook pages, anything!
- 2. Use the png files to cut & paste digitally onto your blog website, personal pics, or pics in any kind of layout that is not for sale.
- 3. Add words to the labels and alter them in any way you like, but you may not claim them as your own despite your modifications.

WHAT YOU CAN'T DO:

- 1. Offer the labels as a digital download on your blogs or websites, whether free or for sale
- 2. Make something with the labels which will later be sold
- 3. Use any of the labels (or modified labels you have altered) in pre-made web templates or pre-made blog themes that will be used by more than 1 person.
- 4. Share them with your book group, knitting circle, coffee clatch, or therapy group.
- 5. Use the labels for any harmful, pornographic, or racist material.
