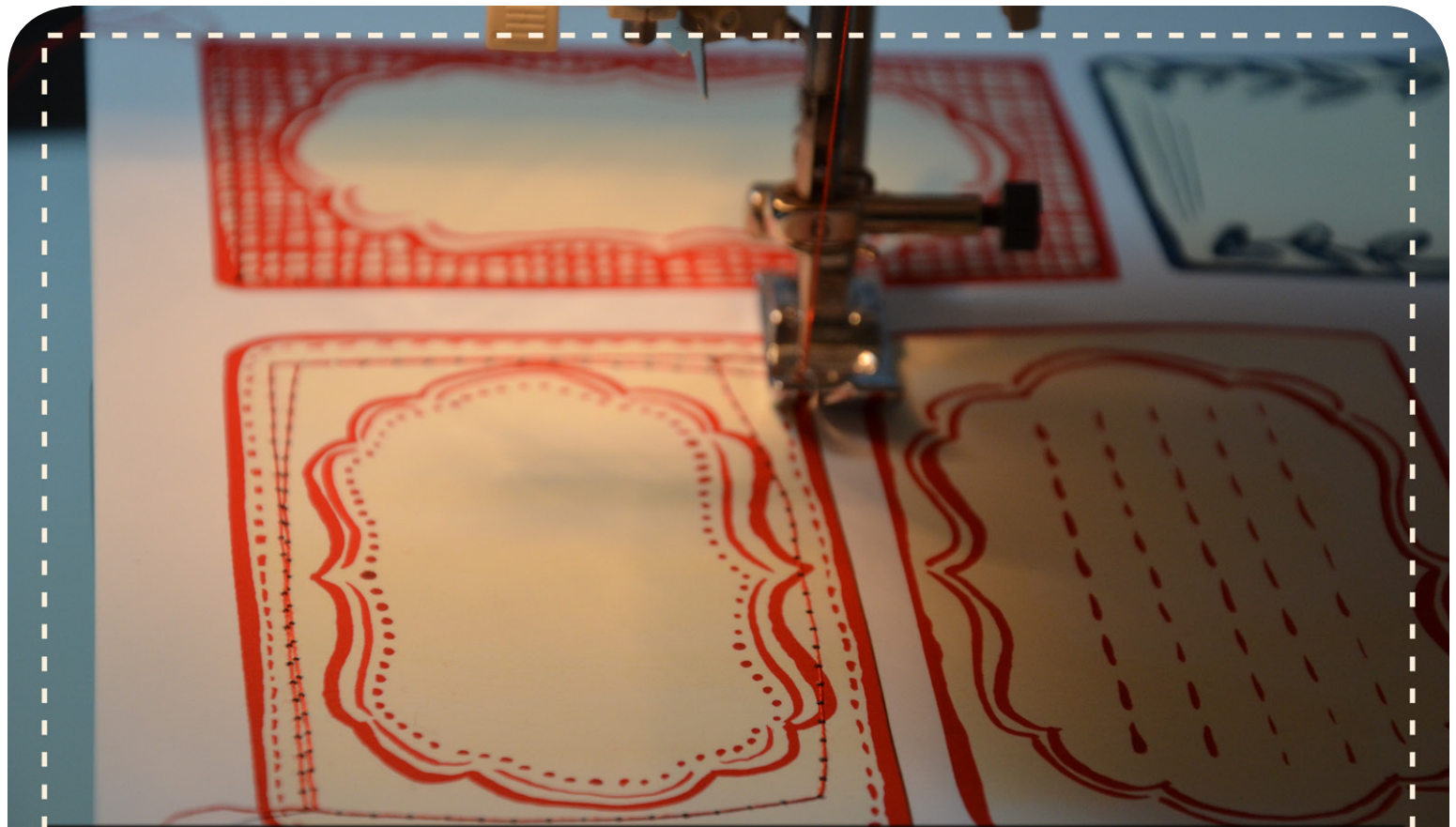

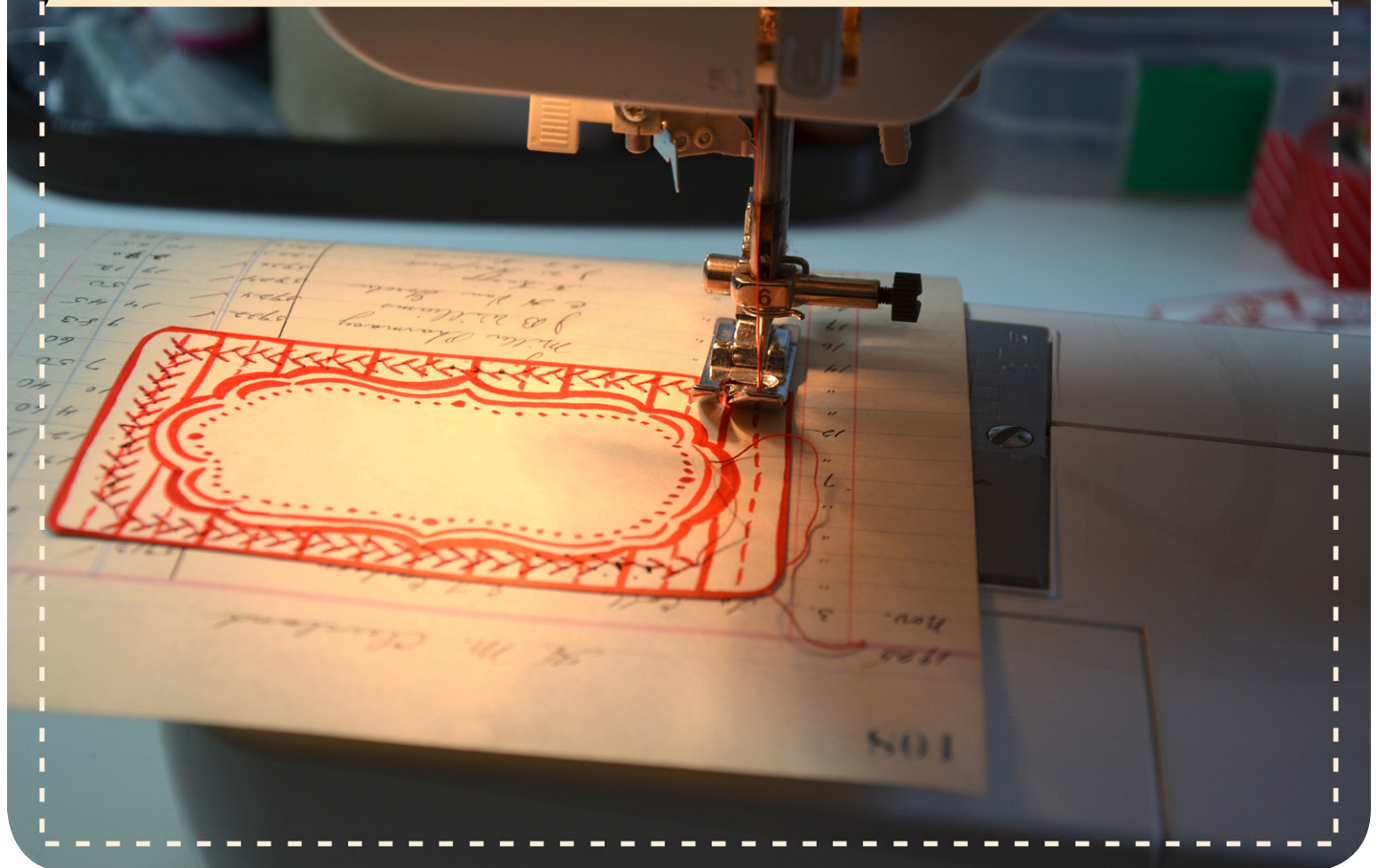
PRINTING Print on matte photo paper for richest color. You can also use white cardstock or a full sheet label. Cut, staple, glue, eyelet, or sew to page.





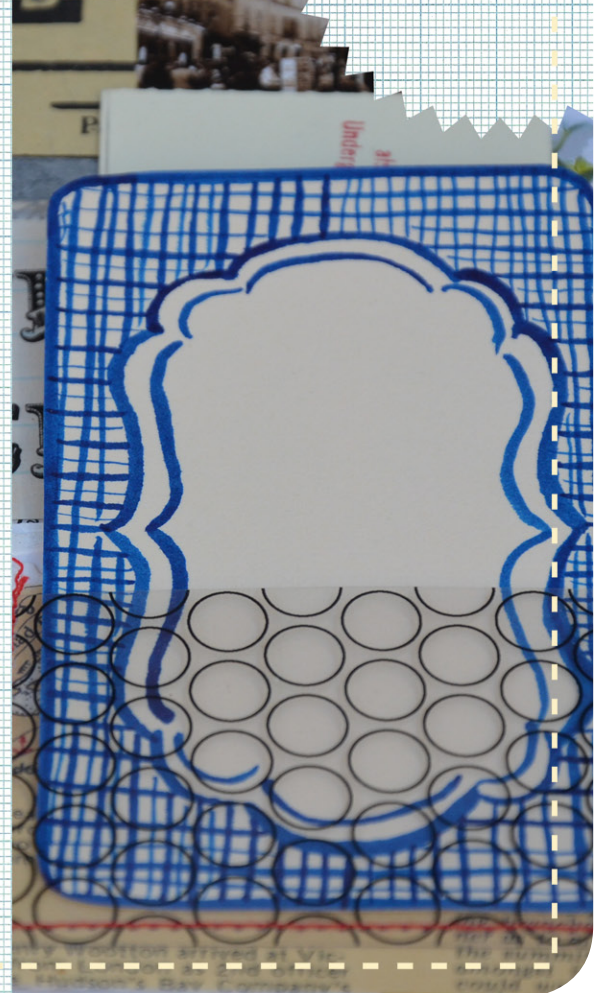
SEWING

5. Use the labels for any harmful, pornographic, or racist material.
